AGRICULTURAL CROP REPORT

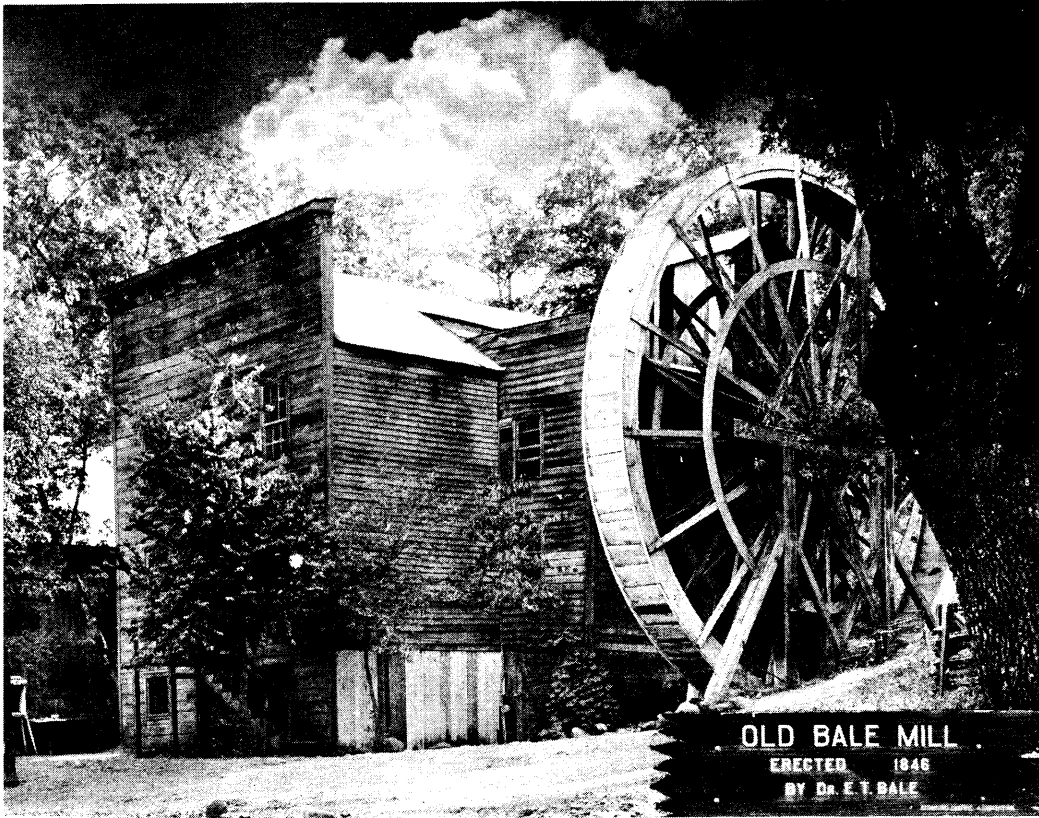


Gentlemen:
