# COOPERATIVE EUROPEAN GRAPEVINE MOTH (EGVM) QUARANTINE PROGRAM COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT

## EXHIBIT A1- NURSERY STOCK (PRODUCTION NURSERY)

### Provisions for the Intrastate and Interstate Movement of Nursery Stock Within and From an EGVM State Interior Quarantine Area

Establishment agrees to the following:

1. **Nursery Inspection:** Premise must be inspected and found free of EGVM prior to first shipment and one time every 30 days.
2. **Integrated Pest Management:** Implement an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) program targeting EGVM as outlined by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) ([http://www.aphis.usda.gov/plant\\_health/plant\\_pest\\_info/eg\\_moth/index.shtml](http://www.aphis.usda.gov/plant_health/plant_pest_info/eg_moth/index.shtml)), the Project, and/or the University of California Cooperative Extension. All IPM treatment records must be retained for a period of three years. Such records shall be made available to the Project upon request.
3. **Special handling for grape (*Vitis sp.*) nursery stock prior to movement:**
  - a) Flowers and fruit must be removed and disposed of as green waste.
  - b) Non-dormant grapevines must be treated with a Project approved treatment\* (available online at: [http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm\\_quarantine.html](http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm_quarantine.html)).
  - c) Dormant grapevines must be treated with a hot water dip for at least five minutes at 127° F (52.7°C).
4. **Special handling for olive (*Olea europaea*) nursery stock prior to movement:**
  - a) Flowers must be removed and disposed of as green waste, *or*
  - b) Plants must be treated in a manner than inhibits flowering and fruiting, *or*
  - c) Plants must be treated with a Project approved treatment\* (available online at: [http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm\\_quarantine.html](http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm_quarantine.html))
5. **Application of treatments must be monitored by the Project.**
6. **Infected Nursery Stock:** If any plant within the nursery is found to be infested with EGVM, Establishment shall immediately notify the Project and not move any EGVM host nursery stock off the premise until such time as the Project can determine that all EGVM host nursery stock on the premise is free of EGVM
7. **Requirements for Movement Within and From Quarantined Areas:** Ensure that quarantine certification accompanies each shipment moved within and from the EGVM quarantine area.
8. **Approved handling for green waste:** All green waste shall be handled as prescribed in Appendix 1 or as specified below (see "special instructions"). **Appendix 1 is available online at:** [http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm\\_quarantine.html](http://www.cdfa.ca.gov/phpps/PE/InteriorExclusion/egvm_quarantine.html)
9. **Maintenance of records:** Maintain all records of intrastate and interstate shipments of all EGVM host nursery stock **to and from** premise for a period of three years. Establishment shall provide such records to the Project upon request.
10. **Training:** Ensure all employees receive training to be compliant with all specifications of this compliance agreement exhibit.
11. **Violation:** Shipments of EGVM host nursery stock found to be in violation of the above stipulations are subject to being held, rejected, destroyed, or subject to other prescribed actions at the discretion of the Project.
