  - **AB 1340 (Adchadjian)** – State Hospitals; Napa County staff seeks to amend AB 1340 to require each State hospital, beginning July 1, 2015, to establish and maintain a security unit as part of each facility to serve State hospital patients who commit crimes while in custody in a host county.
  - **SB 792 (DeSaulnier)** – Regional Planning; requires Joint Policy Committee to prepare a regional organization plan as well as a number of other procedural requirements.
  - **AB 574 (Lowenthal)** – Support for transportation coalition proposal in cap and trade investment plan (CSAC) that sets up a competitive grant process for local governments; grants funded by proceeds from cap and trade auction proceeds.
  - **SB 279 (Hancock)** – San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority; requires locals jurisdictions served by the Authority to use the same letter designation for Authority ballot measures and for the measure to appear before all other county, city, or local measures on the ballot.
  - **SB 182 (Buchanan-Hueso)** – Capital bonds for school and community college districts; limits the ratio of total debt service to principal for each bond series to no more than 4-1 ratio.
