## DOWNLOAD THE RED CROSS EARTHQUAKE APP

People living in earthquake-prone areas are encouraged to download the free Red Cross Earthquake App on their Apple or Android smartphones, which will receive audible alerts when an earthquake occurs in your locality. The app also has information on how to prepare for and what to do during an earthquake and how to safely check your home after the tremors have stopped. You can also set up alerts in the app to let your loved ones know you are okay via your social media network, even when the power is out.

The content is available in both English and Spanish based on the user's language settings on their mobile device.

People can download the app by texting "GETQUAKE" to 90999 or searching "Red Cross Earthquake" in the Apple App Store or Google Play.
