- Set up/take down polling place
- Deliver ballots to drop off point

Be an Election Judge/Clerk or

Voter Assistance Center Clerk:

Saturday-Tuesday, November 5th-8th, 2016

- Earn \$80.00 per day (hours vary)
- Attend training class (earn add'l \$50.00)
- Issue ballots
- Set up/Take down polling place/VAC
- May accompany Inspector to deliver ballots
