DEADLINES FOR SUBMITTING IMPARTIAL ANALYSES,
ARGUMENTS AND REBUTTALS FOR INITIATIVE MEASURES Z, A, B**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN BY THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS that special elections will be held on November 8, 2016 for registered voters of Napa County to decide Initiative Measures Z, A and B

NOTICE is further given that Measure Z shall appear on the ballot at said election:

Water, Parks and Open Space, Restoration and Preservation Measure. To protect drinking water by preserving and restoring watersheds, rivers, creeks; protect natural open spaces and wildlife habitat; reduce wildfire risk; and maintain parks and trails; shall Napa County enact a 1/4 percent sales tax for the Napa County Regional Park and Open Space District raising an estimated eight million dollars annually for fourteen years with citizen oversight, annual audits, and funds that cannot be taken by the State? NOTICE is further given that Measure A shall appear on the ballot at said election:

Shall Napa County Ordinance No. 2016-04 be adopted? (Compromise ordinance requiring the Animal Shelter to do the following in a cost effective way: (i) prepare behavioral and medical evaluations for impounded or surrendered dogs, cats and rabbits before destruction, (ii) work with non-profit animal organizations, (iii) provide veterinary care, socialization, and exercise, and (v) publish a list of nonprofit animal organizations and a list of statistical release rates of dogs, cats, and rabbits.) NOTICE is further given that Measure B shall appear on the ballot at said election:

Napa County Ordinance No. 2016-03 be adopted? (Amends the Napa County Code requiring the Animal Shelter to (i) prepare behavioral and medical evaluations for impounded or surrendered dogs, cats and rabbits before destruction, (ii) work with non-profit animal organizations, (iii) provide veterinary care, socialization, and exercise using all resources available, and (v) publish a list of nonprofit animal organizations and a list of statistical release rates of dogs, cats, and rabbits. NOTICE is further given that the impartial analyses by the County Counsel, in the form required by section 9160(b) of the Elections Code, shall be prepared and filed with the Registrar of Voters on or before 5:00 p.m., August 12, 2016.

NOTICE is further given that the final date for submission to the Registrar of Voters of arguments not to exceed 300 words in length for or against the measures shall be August 19, 2016, and that such arguments shall be submitted to the Registrar at 900 Coombs Street, Rm. 256, Napa, California 94559, no later than 4:30 p.m. on said day. Arguments must be accompanied by a statement that the argument is true and correct pursuant to Elections Code section 9600.

NOTICE is further given that if arguments are submitted both for and against the proposed measures, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The final date for submission to the Registrar of Voters of rebuttal arguments for or against the measures to the extent rebuttal arguments are permitted by section 9167 of the Elections Code shall be August 26, 2016, no later than 5:00 p.m. on said day. Rebuttal arguments must be accompanied by a statement that the rebuttal to the argument is true and correct pursuant to Elections Code section 9600.
