#### **4. PRESENTATION FROM SHARED VISION CONSULTANTS**

Shared Vision Consultants has been hired to ensure we were maximizing our funding by leveraging resources and building out a system of care for juveniles in Napa County. This is a very important piece of planning for future success as the State has realigned all juvenile services from the state level to local jurisdictions. It is not only important to look at the SB 823 youth but those who have not yet committed a 707(b) offense to proactively try to prevent greater penetration into the juvenile justice system. Probation has put together a team of staff who will be working with the consultants to identify underserved communities, better understand their needs and how we can proactively create innovative solutions to both target prevention and intervention for youth and families.

The scope of work and timelines for this project was presented. It was designed to come up with prevention, intervention, and transition services for young people, developing a system of care that would reduce the number of youth involved in the criminal justice system. There was

discussion around the four (4) phases to this, which are Pre-Plan Logistics, Probation Departments System of Care Plan Development, System of Care Plan Execution, and Plan Reporting. As this process rolls out, we may set a special meeting if there is a lot of movement to provide updates or if there are different asks along this project. As you think of stakeholders, you can email those names to Kristin as she will be keeping track of that information.

## 5. SB 823 SECURE TRACK UPDATE

Plan development underway for Secure Track youth. There are no youth returning from DJJ. We had one young adult who was transferred from DJJ to CDCR and he was released on Post Release Community Supervision in Adult. There is a contract in place with Sonoma County should we require a Secure Track for a youth; however, our intent is to not have to use that if at all possible. We want to keep our youth local. We are building the camp program and are looking at all of the available resources to build a state of the art program. Most of our youth are nearing adulthood and we need to look at not only services that can benefit the youth right now but also services that they can connect to in order to sustain as adults. We will continue to update as the camp program is being built.

There was a change to the SB 823 funding streams; in FY 21/22, we received \$250K. In FY 22/23, we anticipated getting \$413K as the state reported to us but we ended up only receiving \$286K (a difference of \$126k). In FY 23/24, we still anticipate getting \$693K; however, given the allocation formula change, we may not receive that money.
