REQUEST DESCRIPTION / JUSTIFICATION:**Description (100 words maximum)**

In 2017 Napa County successfully implemented color-coded pediatric measuring cards and tape for safe medication administration. This has proved to be a vitally important tool and has greatly improved accuracy of all pediatric medication administrations. There were some gaps identified on the cards, eg. the coloring for 37kg-40kg, that need to be addressed. This application is to request updated versions of the pediatric measuring cards, that includes two new medications; Oral Glucose and Glucagon.

Pediatric Connection (100 words maximum)

Dr. Broselow's color-coded measurement system has been the gold standard in calculating pediatric patient weight for over thirty years. This system applies these methods in a simple, accurate, and cost effective system that has the capacity to grow as our system evolves with the changes in literature associated with pediatric medication administration. The use of this tool should continue to help improve dosing accuracy for pediatric patients.
