Requests for disability related modifications or accommodations, aids or services may be made to the Mental Health Board Secretary's office no less than 72 hours prior to the meeting date by phoning (707) 299-2101. **Note:** Due to COVID-19 restrictions, these monthly meetings currently take place utilizing Zoom video conferencing.

All materials relating to an agenda item for an open session of a regular meeting of the Mental Health Board which are provided to a majority or all of the members of the Board by Board members, staff or the public within 72 hours of but prior to the meeting will be available for public inspection, on and after at the time of such distribution, in the office of the Mental Health Board Secretary, 2751 Napa Valley Corporate Drive, Building A, Napa, California 94558, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., except for County holidays. Materials distributed to a majority or all of the members of the Board at the meeting will be available for public inspection at the public meeting if prepared by the members of the Board or County staff and after the public meeting if prepared by some other person. Availability of materials related to agenda items for public inspection does not include materials which are exempt from public disclosure under Government Code sections 6253.5, 6254, 6254.3, 6254.7, 6254.15, 6254.16, or 6254.22..

ANY MEMBER OF THE AUDIENCE DESIRING TO ADDRESS THE BOARD ON A MATTER NOT ON THE AGENDA may do so under the Public Comment portion of this agenda. Give your name and your comments or questions. As required by the Government Code, no action or discussion will be undertaken on any item raised during the Public Comment period.

Time limitations shall be three minutes per speaker.

In this time period, anyone may address the Mental Health Board of Napa County regarding any subject over which the Board has jurisdiction, but which is not on today's posted agenda. In order to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak, time limitations shall be at the discretion of the Chair.

No action or discussion will be undertaken on any item raised during this Public Comment period except that Mental Health Board members or its staff may briefly respond to statements made or questions posed. In addition, in response to questions posed, the Mental Health Board may ask a question for clarification, request staff to report back at a subsequent meeting concerning the question posed, or direct staff to place the matter on a future agenda.

4. **SPECIAL MEETING BUSINESS – (Action Item)**

- A. Pursuant to AB 361, any legislative body that does meet via teleconference must, within 30 days after that meeting, make findings that determine 1) that the state of emergency continues, and 2) that social distancing is still recommended.

The sole purpose of this meeting is to review the findings and vote on whether to continue to hold the Napa County Mental Health Board monthly meeting via Zoom teleconference.
