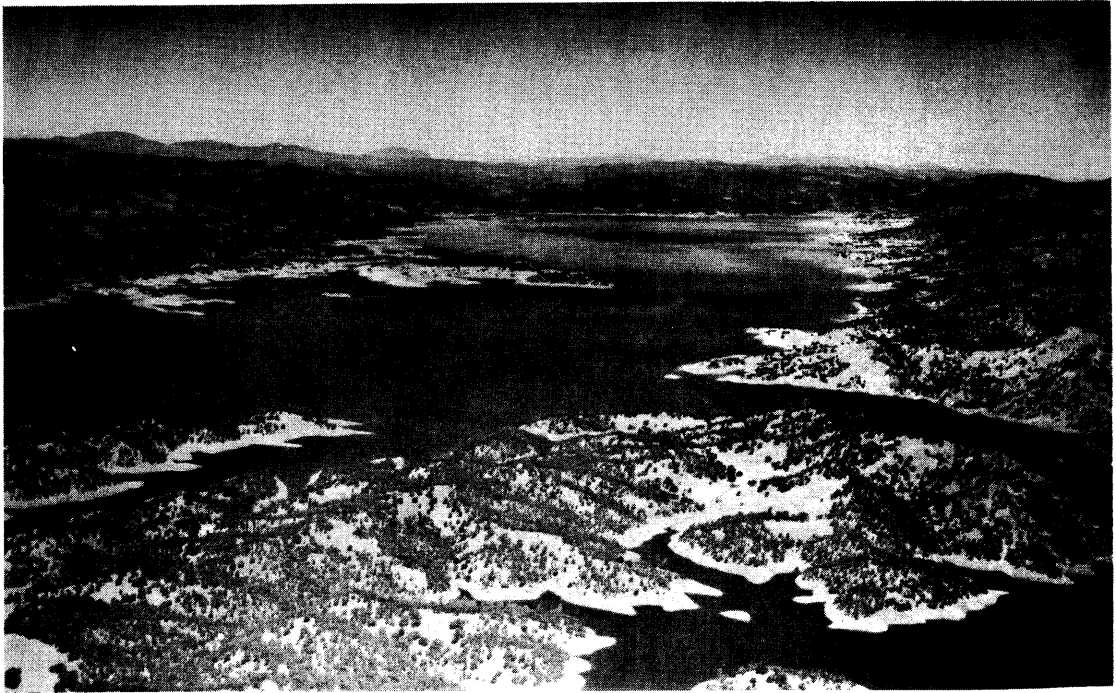


# 1959 Annual Crop Report

## Napa County



**LAKE BERRYESSA . . .** While this is looked upon as a recreational project, actually it was developed to provide irrigation waters for thousands of fertile acres of agricultural land. The lake was formed in Berryessa Valley, behind Monticello Dam, and stores up to 1,600,000 acre feet of Putah Creek water. Facilities for recreation have been built and now the area is a vast playground for holiday and vacation visitors. The lake is about 22 miles long and has a shoreline of over 100 miles, all in Napa County.
