

# First 30 days - What to do

Medical, Dental, Mental Health (CHDP)

**\*this timeline is from the day of placement of the child(ren)**

Immediate	72 hours	Within 30 days of Foster Care Placement	Routine Well Child Exam Schedule
<p><b>Same day of Foster care placement:</b>  <b>If your child needs urgent or emergent care, seek care at the closest medical facility to your home, Queen of the Valley ER or Kaiser Permanente Vallejo ER.</b></p> <p>If the child placed in your home is ill, seek appropriate medical services by calling the child's Pediatrician or Primary Care Provider for a same day appointment.</p> <p>Call Napa County Child Welfare Services Emergency Response at (707)253-4262 to report urgent or emergent child illnesses.</p> <p>Call Foster Care Public Health Nurse at (707)259-8723 for follow-up on Immediate health care needs.</p> <p>A foster child should be evaluated immediately for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Injury</li> <li>• Head trauma</li> <li>• Drug exposure or</li> </ul>	<p><b>By 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Foster care placement</b></p> <p>72 hour health screening at child's medical home may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Follow-up on same day Urgent care medical visit</li> <li>• Refills of existing medications (such as Asthma medications)</li> <li>• Request medical records from other providers</li> <li>• Psychotropic medication refill</li> <li>• Newborn follow-up</li> </ul> <p>*Child may receive the 72-hour health screening and the 30 Foster Care CHDP physical exam at the same visit.</p> <p><b>*If the Foster Care CHDP Well Child physical exam is not completed during this visit, schedule it.</b></p> <p>**Documentation of the 72 hour health screening and the Foster Care physical exam is imperative. One Health Contact Form can be used for both screening and</p>	<p><b>By day 30, the Foster Care Physical exam must be completed and should include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foster Care CHDP Well Child physical examination and Immunization update given</li> <li>• Health history</li> <li>• Laboratories or testing</li> <li>• Referrals to Specialist</li> <li>• Mental health follow-up</li> <li>• Follow-up from 72 hour health screening</li> <li>• Ages and Stages Questionnaire/ Developmental assessment by Physician or Nurse Practitioner</li> </ul> <p>*Some items may be done at Foster Care CHDP Physical examination or at scheduled follow-up visits.</p> <p>**Documentation of this Physical examination is imperative.</p>	<p><b>Periodicity for Newborns and Infants:</b></p> <p>2 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            4 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            6 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            9 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            12 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            15-18 month Well Child examination and Immunizations            2 Year Well Child examination (Immunizations as needed)</p> <p><b>2 Year and Older Well Child Exam</b>            After completion of the 2 Year Well Child examination, annual Well Child exams are required for all foster children and youth.</p> <p><b>Adolescent Immunization</b>            Adolescent Immunizations are due at 11-12 years of age and include:            Menactra (Meningococcal)            HPV series (Human Papillomavirus)            TDaP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)            Flu shot recommended annually.</p> <p>**Documentation of these Well Child exams and Immunizations are imperative.</p>
