**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN BY THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS** that a special all-mail ballot election will be held on May 19, 2020 for registered voters of the Lake Berryessa Resort Improvement District to decide whether to establish an appropriations limit for fiscal years 2020-2021 through 2023-2024.

**NOTICE** is further given that Measure T shall appear on the ballot at said election:

**NOTICE** is further given that the impartial analysis by the County Counsel, in the form required by section 9160(b) of the Elections Code, shall be prepared and filed with the Registrar of Voters, by Friday, February 21, 2020 on or before 5:00 p.m.

**NOTICE** is further given that the final date for submission to the Registrar of Voters of arguments not to exceed 300 words in length for or against the measure shall be Friday February 28, 2020, and that such arguments shall be submitted to the Registrar at 1127 1<sup>st</sup> St Ste E Napa, California 94559, no later than 4:30 p.m. on said day. Arguments must be accompanied by a statement that the argument is true and correct pursuant to Elections Code section 9600.

**NOTICE** is further given that if arguments are submitted both for and against the proposed measure, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The final date for submission to the Registrar of Voters of rebuttal arguments for or against the measure to the extent rebuttal arguments are permitted by section 9167 of the Elections Code shall be Friday, March 6, 2020, no later than 5:00 p.m. on said day. Rebuttal arguments must be accompanied by a statement that the rebuttal to the argument is true and correct pursuant to Elections Code section 9600.
