Date: May 21, 2019	Re: Policy Updates

Effective May 22, 2019, several policy and treatment updates will take effect. The Napa County Multi-Casualty Incident Management Plan has been updated to provide an easier format to follow, a threshold for activation, operational guideline references, and integration into the ReddiNet program which will be rolling out over the next few months. In addition to the plan, we have updated Administrative Policy 403, Multi-Casualty Incidents to reflect the updates to the plan.

In addition to the MCI Plan, and Administrative Policy, we have updated several clinical guidelines:

- The Adenosine Medication Card has been updated to reflect dosing consistent with C-06 Supraventricular Tachycardia.
- M-08 Sepsis has been updated to remove any limitations for activating receiving facilities with a sepsis alert if a provider has sufficient evidence to activate.
- AP-09 Fluid Challenge has been updated to address the objective to achieve an optimum systolic blood pressure of 90 mmHg.
- AP-13 Pain Management has been updated to allow more for paramedic judgement when administering pharmacological therapy.
