## **June 2-4 Curfew Order Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What area of Napa County is impacted by the curfew order?**

The curfew is in effect in the City of American Canyon and the unincorporated area up to Jameson Canyon (SR 12/SR 29) and to the East and West of the City of American Canyon. The cities of Napa, St. Helena, Calistoga and the Town of Yountville ARE NOT under a curfew order at this time.

### **What does this mean to me if I am in the curfew area?**

This mandatory curfew requires people in the curfew area to stay home between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. beginning Tuesday, June 2, 2020 and until Thursday, June 4, 2020 at 5:00 a.m.

### **May I drive to work?**

Yes. Those who are in the course of traveling directly to and from work are exempt from the curfew.

### **May I seek medical assistance?**

Yes. Those who are in the course of traveling directly to and from medical services or obtaining or providing medical services are exempt from the curfew. This includes medical facilities and pharmacies.

### **Am I allowed to go to work or operate my business during the curfew hours?**

Only medical facilities, pharmacies and gas stations may be open to the public from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. The curfew allows individuals to travel to-and-from their place of employment.

### **Can I be at a friend or family member's home during the curfew?**

The curfew is in place to prevent individuals from being out on the streets overnight during this time of civil unrest. Be advised that State of California's Shelter At Home order remains in place to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Please continue to stay home as much as possible to protect each other from the virus.

### **Why a curfew?**

The curfew is meant to keep our community safe and was ordered following several nights of civil unrest in our neighboring cities and counties, during which incidents of violence and vandalism occurred. Please stay home for your own safety and to assist our law enforcement officers with protecting property and keeping our community safe.
