Collection Service

Business garbage rates are based on the size and frequency of service. Garbage collection is available in a variety of size containers – including carts (35, 65, or 95 gallon), bins (2 to 6 yards), roll-off boxes (10 to 30 yards), and compactors. Please call for more information. Upper valley businesses also receive free recycling and yard trimmings collection along with their garbage service. Service is available in carts.

What Goes in Your Recycling Bin?

Clean Paper



- Cardboard (must be broken down)
- Boxboard (e.g. shoe boxes, cereal boxes)
- Office paper (all colors)
- Magazines, catalogs & glossy paper
- Soft-cover books
- Envelopes (labels or windows OK)
- Newspaper
- Shredded paper in clear bag

Rigid Plastic



- Rinsed & Empty
- All CRV containers accepted
- Bottles & jugs (all colors)
- Tubs & containers (e.g. margarine)
- Food service trays & deli containers

Metal



- Aluminum cans
- Tin & steel cans
- Clean aluminum pans & foil
- Empty aerosol cans
- Loose lids from jars
- Small scrap metal
- Pots, pans & utensils

Glass

- Glass
- Bottles & jars
- All colors, lids removed
- Rinsed & empty (labels okay)

Mandatory Commercial Recycling and Composting

AB 341 - The State of California currently requires all businesses and agencies that generate four or more cubic yards of waste per week to recycle.



AB 1826 - The State also requires businesses that generate food scraps, landscape trimmings, clean wood or grape pomace ensure those materials are composted. The law applies to all businesses or agencies that generate and discard two cubic yards or more of waste per week.

Legal Disposal of Hazardous Wastes

HAZARDOUS WASTES such as fluorescent lamps/tubes, automotive fluids, pesticides and fertilizers, paint products, cleaners, batteries, etc. cannot be placed in the bins or carts.



Upper Valley Waste Management Agency sponsors twice yearly hazardous waste collection events. Typically events are held in April in St. Helena and in October in Calistoga. Businesses are charged a fee for this disposal service and appointments are required.
