The Napa Department of Corrections understands how important it is to you and your loved ones that we put their safety first. The Director of Corrections has been working closely with County Law Enforcement Chiefs, the County Health Officer and other Governmental Agencies. During these unprecedented times we are responding accordingly and our responses are based on the latest health directives.

- To date we have done the following as we continue to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic:
 - Following the Emergency Bail Schedule for misdemeanor and felony offenses.
 - Screening all arrestees for symptoms prior to entering the facility.
 - Established a dedicated Quarantine/Isolation housing unit.
 - Instituted a 14 day quarantine period when booked into NCDC. The inmates are tested and monitored by medical staff for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. Once the inmate is cleared, the inmate will be re-housed based on classification and routinely monitored thereafter.
 - Inmates assigned permanent housing are screened routinely for signs and symptoms.
 - All staff are screened prior to entering the facility each day.
 - To limit exposure, the Department has instituted a policy that all staff shall wear a mask while on duty and inmates shall wear their issued mask when out of their cell.
 - On the living units, time in the dayroom is being conducted on a rotational basis to permit proper social distancing. This also allows for inmates to shower, watch television, utilize the phone and visit via video.
 - We are conducting off-site video visitation through our communication vendor, "Securus". Inmates are receiving 2 free video visits each week while face to face public visits are temporarily suspended.
 - Increased cleaning procedures on the housing units and all areas of the jail.
 - All Programming has been temporarily suspended.
 - Video arraignments have been started.
 - Mental Health and Medical Services are available 24 hours a day. Inmates can submit a request anytime.
 - Posted hand sanitizer stations and signage throughout the facility available to inmates and staff.
 - All Legal visits are being conducted on a non-contact basis from Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
