Applicants sought for the Napa Valley Transportation Authority Active Transportation Advisory Committee

NAPA – The County Executive Officer announces two openings on the **Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) Active Transportation Advisory Committee (ATAC)**, representing the following category:

- Two (2) General Public Napa County representatives

Recruitment will remain open until the vacancies are filled.

Advisory Committee Purpose: ATAC is an advisory committee for the Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) established by the NVTA’s Board of Directors to promote and encourage safe bicycling and walking to further Napa County’s goal of becoming a bicycle- and pedestrian-friendly community. The ATAC focuses on Napa County’s interest to increase the safe usage of bicycle and pedestrian facilities as a significant and beneficial mode of transportation in order to reduce congestion, improve air quality and community health. The ATAC advises the NVTA Board of Directors on funding and planning for bicycle and pedestrian projects and programs, and makes recommendations on the policies for the planning, development, and maintenance of active transportation systems.

Qualifications: Individuals representing the general public must be active transportation advocates who live or work in the cities/town or Napa County. The Board of Supervisors nominate individuals to represent the unincorporated area with final appointments made by the Napa Valley Transportation Authority Board. Terms are for three years from the date of NVTA Board approval, typically one month following the Board of Supervisors nomination.
