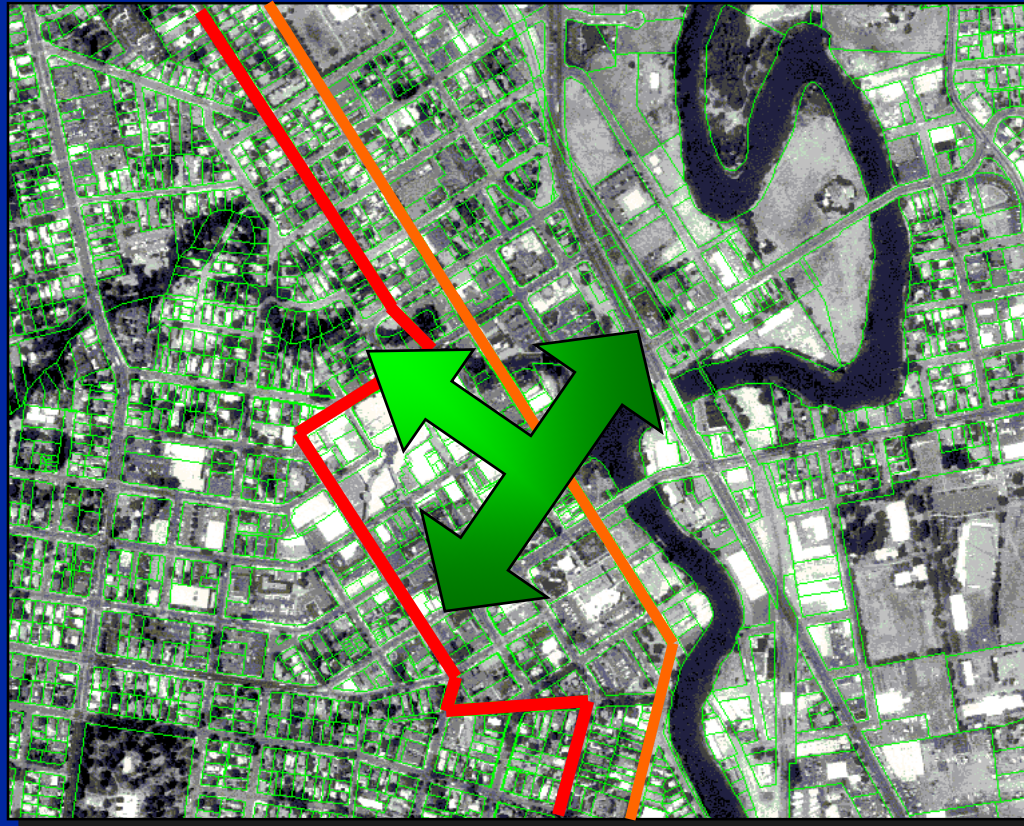

# 2021 Redistricting

---

## Redistricting Overview

- Guiding principle is “one person, one vote”
- Uses 2020 Census Data when released
- Follows guidelines of FAIR MAPS ACT
- The purpose of redistricting is to define areas of ***equal population*** to assure that people are equitably represented by their elected government officials
- Community of Interest Outreach can begin prior to receipt of census data and drawing of maps to provide outlines of process.

# 2021 Redistricting

---

## **Where is Napa County in the Process?**

- Napa County is contracting with Redistricting Partners to prepare public input schedule and draft proposals for supervisor district and trustee area boundaries
- Redistricting Partners will provide a means for the public to prepare and submit district/trustee area proposals
- Costs will be shared by County, Napa Community College and Napa County Board of Education

# 2021 Redistricting

---

## **What Is the Schedule?**

- Community outreach will begin in March or April to outline redistricting process
- Draft map options and public ability to make proposals will be available as soon as census data is released
- Final supervisor district boundaries will be adopted by the Board of Supervisors before December 15, 2021 and final trustee area boundaries by NVC and NCOE before May 15, 2022
