incumbent does not file Nomination Papers by March 11, 2022.

March 17, 2022 Random Alpha

(E-82) Randomized alphabet drawing done by the Secretary of State to

determine the order of candidates on the ballot.

April 11, 2022 May 24, 2022 Write-in Period

(E-57 – E-14) Nomination Petitions to become a qualified write-in candidate

shall be filed during this period.

May 9, 2022 Vote by Mail Period Starts

(E-29) This is the first day that Vote by Mail Ballots can be mailed to

voters.

May 23, 2022 15 Day Close

(E-15) This is the last day a voter can register to vote and receive a ballot
