





The Measure L funding expenditures list is fraught with duplication of services and questionable purchases. How the County intends to spend our tax money is not clearly and specifically spelled out. 31

The measure ignores other funding that has been, and is, available. For example, the State has directed \$138 million in funding for fire prevention projects that would help protect communities, including Napa, across California. Wildfire prevention grants are available through California's State Department of Forestry and Fire Prevention (CAL FIRE). 44

The Napa County Taxpayers Association considers the information provided in this Measure to be inadequate to insure that the funds collected will be controlled and spent only on specifically designated projects. This tax imposes a new expense on local residents who are already dealing with an historically high inflation rate. This new tax can only add to the budget problems they are faced with at their grocery stores and gas pumps.


