





We are not all in this together ! Here are some reasons why:

A recent report of the recommended county budget for 2021-2022 show projected revenue increases of \$13,6 million (10.6% +). We believe very few of the residents of Napa County will have an increase this large in their income in 2021-2022.

Measure L is the wrong measure for Napa County. In 2021 a contractor made a five year, \$ 42 million proposal to the Board of Supervisors which would accomplish the same goals as this Measure vs the proposed 10 year \$ 100 million cost of this new tax. 94

Measure L will be a regressive Sales Tax and most severely affect Families with the lowest income - School Bonds, SF Bay Restoration, Sewer Assessment, and Sales Taxes add up. Today gas prices are climbing higher with California having the highest prices in the Nation. Citizens of Napa County are being weighed down by these economic burdens. 51

The Community needs more Transparency and Input into a Fire Protection Program. Measure L is replete with jumbled language, unexplained accounting practices and overlapping programs. It will put in place purchases and continuing expenditures that will long outlast the 10 year \$100 million cost of the proposed tax.


Napa County does not need to impose this special tax burden on all residents of Napa County.
