Bus

The Vine Transit website offers a variety of choices for bus trip options with maps and schedules. The bus system connects the Napa Valley to the rest of the Bay Area with service to BART, the Vallejo Ferry, the Fairfield-Suisun Transit Center, and the Suisun Train Station (Capital Corridor/Amtrak).

NVTA: VineGo On Demand Paratransit Shuttle Service

This special type of transportation service is limited to persons who are unable to independently use regular public transit, some or all the time, due to a disability or a health related condition.

VineGo picks up passengers at their home and will take them to any destinations within Napa County as well as Kaiser Vallejo. Round trips and same day reservations are welcome. All rides are scheduled over the phone. Vinego is available 7 days a week and fares range anywhere from \$3.20-\$6.40, but discounted price passes are available. An in person assessment is required as part of the application process, but VineGo can provide transportation to this.
