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### **Applicant sought for the Napa County Emergency Medical Care Committee**

NAPA – The County Executive Officer announces one opening representing Public Member on the Napa County Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC). The term of office will commence immediately upon appointment by the Board of Supervisors and expire January 31, 2026.

#### **Recruitment will remain open until the vacancy is filled.**

The EMCC consists of seventeen (17) members: two “Public Members” representing the community at large and appointed by the Board of Supervisors, one Board of Supervisors representative, and fourteen “Agency Members” serving as designated representatives of their agencies. These agencies represent interests in emergency medical services throughout Napa County.

The purpose of the EMCC as stated in Sections 1797.274 and 1797.276 of the Health and Safety Code is to, at least annually, 1) Review the operations of ambulance services operating within the County and emergency medical care offered within the County, including programs for training large numbers of people in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and lifesaving first aid techniques, 2) Submit recommendations to the Board of Supervisors, and 3) Report to the State Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) and the Napa County EMS Agency in an advisory capacity. Meetings are held three times a year, and members are expected to not only attend all EMCC meetings, but also meetings of the Public Information and Education Subcommittee, if assigned.
