## MARCH 7, 2023 CITY OF CALISTOGA COMMUNITY FACILITIES FAIRGROUNDS SPECIAL TAX ELECTION

Napa County has adopted the Voter's Choice Act which means that Calistoga voters have more ways and more days to cast their ballot. All voters registered by Tuesday February 21, 2023 will receive a vote by mail ballot. An official Ballot Drop Box will be located outside of CalMart available 24/7 beginning Tuesday February 7, 2023. Eligible citizens can register to vote in person and cast their ballot at our office beginning Monday February 6, 2023 through Election Day or at the Calistoga Vote Center, which opens at the Calistoga Community Center on Election Day Tuesday March 7, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Every voter can be sure that their vote by mail ballot will be counted as long as they sign the return envelope and the ballot is received in our office; dropped in the Official Ballot Drop Box; delivered to the Vote Center or postmarked before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Return ballot envelopes postmarked on Election Day are valid if they are received in our office by Tuesday March 14, 2023.

Vote-by-mail ballot processing including signature verification will begin Wednesday, February 15, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. It takes about two days from our receipt of a vote by mail ballot until it is entered into our database. Counting of ballots processed through Monday, March 6, 2023 will begin at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, March 7, 2023 – Election Day. Initial vote by mail results will be released at 8:01 p.m. on Election Day.
