**Applicants sought for Napa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District**  
**“Floating” Alternate Director**

NAPA – The Napa County Executive Office announces the opening of one “floating” alternate position on the Board of Directors of the Napa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District. Applications are invited from the public at large. No specialized professional background or experience is required however, the applicant must reside within the Flood District.

The Board of Directors of the Napa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District consists of eleven members:

- Five Directors are members of the Napa County Board of Supervisors who each have two votes;
- One Director is the Mayor of the City of Napa who has two votes;
- Four Directors are the Mayors of the Cities of Calistoga, St. Helena, American Canyon and the Town of Yountville who each have one vote; and
- One Director is a member of the City Council of the City of Napa who has one vote.

Effective January 1, 2003, the State Legislature approved SB 1352, which makes the vice-mayors the alternate directors for the city members of the District Board and allows the Board of Supervisors to appoint two (2) members of the public, residing within the District, to serve as first and second floating alternates, respectively, to serve as Directors if one or two members of the Board of Supervisors are absent from the District Board for any reason.
