

CERTIFICATION OF ADJACENT AGRICULTURAL USE

A certification by the property owner is necessary to obtain a building permit for any construction adjacent to land used for commercial agricultural purposes. Napa County Code Section 15.08.0404 (B)

The undersigned do hereby certify to be the owner(s) of the hereinafter legally described real property and do hereby acknowledge that the proposed development is adjacent to property utilized for commercial agricultural purposes. Persons who may work or reside in any of the proposed structures may be subjected to inconvenience or discomfort arising from the use of agricultural chemicals, including herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers; and from the pursuit of agricultural operations, including plowing, spraying, pruning and harvesting which occasionally generates dust, smoke, noise and odor. Napa County has established agriculture as a priority use on agricultural lands, and residents of adjacent property should be prepared to accept such inconvenience or discomfort from normal, necessary farm operations as set forth in Napa County Code section 2.94.030.
