Application Fees:

Application fee for processing a grading extension is \$141.00 in accordance with the Napa County Policy Manual Section 75.020(c) as revised by the Board of Supervisors on July 31, 2018, Resolution 2018-102. There will be a 3.3% surcharge added per Section 75.015. Please see attached condition #5 for additional stormwater inspection fees that may apply.

Approval of Grading Extensions are granted with the Applicant's agreement of the following:

1. All work shall be performed as conditioned in the Grading/Building Permit associated with the project. No grading work may be conducted in the shutdown period until a grading extension letter is issued.
2. All work shall remain in compliance with County Stormwater Ordinance 1240 during all phases of the project, Owner/Operator of approved project is required to implement accepted best management practices for stormwater pollution control.
3. All earthwork must cease and a Weather Triggered Action Plan (WTAP) implemented if the chance of rain is 40% or greater for that day (including weekends), according to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Work may resume once the chance of rain is less than 40% for a 24 hour period.
4. Preventative stormwater pollution/erosion control measures must be in place and effective prior to predicted rainfall to protect stormwater conveyance ways from any illicit discharge resulting from activities related to the above named project. All perimeter control measures such as silt fence and fiber rolls will be installed and in place at all times after October 15th. All other erosion control materials will be available and onsite at all times.
5. In addition to any Grading Extension Application fees, further stormwater inspection fees shall be charged to the existing Grading/Building permit. The inspections are to ensure that all grading activity performed in the non-grading season is in conformance with permit conditions and NPDES requirements. The number of inspection is dependant on the quality of installation and maintenance of the project's BMP.
