The Master Plan of Skyline Park



- Partnership Initiatives (p.44 Skyline Master Plan)
 - 1. Work together to ensure the permanent protection of Skyline Wilderness Park as a public park through local acquisition of the property from the State of California.
 - 2. Work together to protect the integrity of the park and to increase the benefits it provides, including potential expansion of the park to the south and east.

The General Plan



- Gen Plan: Goal CON-6: Preserve, sustain, and restore forests, woodlands, and commercial timberland for **their economic, environmental, recreation, and open space values.**
- Within the Conservation (CON) Element the managed production of resources is specifically identified and addressed. This element states that the preserving open space resources to meet the community's conservation goals while also addressing local needs for productive raw natural materials requires a **balanced approach** and contains specific goals and policies that address open space as it pertains to the conservation of natural resources, and stresses the conservation and prudent management of the County's mineral resources for current and future generations.

 - Neighboring East Imola neighborhood concerned, despite feeling out of the loop due to language
- **CEASE Coalition (Coalition Engaged Against Syar Expansion)**
- **16 Months of Hearings!**

What Do We Want From YOU?



- **Commitment to the Public Interest**
 - Rejection of the Expansion
 - Conditions of Approval
 - ✦ Independent Monitoring of Syar's Activities with Greater Regularity
 - ✦ Buffers Between the Park and the Quarry
 - 200-300 feet along the border with immediate oak plantings
 - Exclude Passini Ranch from the expansion
 - ✦ Require Syar to Put in Writing the Permanent Exclusion of Skyline Trail
