# Commercial Cultivation

- Current legal restrictions
    - No organic label until state adopts program c. 2021
    - Only considered “agricultural product” for purposes of MAUCRSA, not other agriculture laws
    - New form of cultivation cooperatives

# Commercial Cultivation

- Draft regulations – Cultivation Site
    - Scale diagram showing details of premises
    - Lighting diagram for indoor/mixed-light
    - Waste disposal requirements
    - Standards of cleanliness
    - Packaging requirements including tamper-evident

# Commercial Cultivation

- Draft regulations – Cultivation Site (con't)
    - Environmental protection measures such as prohibiting generators, limits on pesticides, proper power supply
    - Track and trace participation
    - List of fines for violations of numerous provisions

# Commercial Cultivation

- Taxes
    - Flower = \$9.25 per ounce
    - Leaves = \$2.75 per ounce

# Personal Cultivation

- Current legal restrictions
    - 6 plants allowed
    - Any private residence
      - Landlord, not local jurisdiction, may ban
      - “Private residence” is per unit, not per parcel
    - Caregiver may grow for up to 5 patients

# Personal Cultivation

- Local regulatory authority
    - Cannot reduce below 6 plants
    - Outdoor – can ban and limit
    - Indoor – may only “reasonably regulate”
      - Likely cannot ban completely, even via setbacks and zoning
      - Cannot ban 6 plants grown indoors in private residence or in accessory structure of private residence
  - Legal challenges to come – 1 pending
