Cannabis Public Health and Safety

Overview



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Personal Use Restrictions

- No smoking:
 - ✓ Where tobacco prohibited
 - ✓ 1,000 feet of school, day care center, or youth center while children present unless within private residence
 - No smoking or ingesting:
 - ✓ Public place
 - ✓ While operating vehicle or passenger
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Personal Use Restrictions

- No smoking, ingesting, or possession:
 - ✓ On school, day care center, or youth center grounds while children present
 - Other restrictions:
 - ✓ No open container in vehicle
 - ✓ No manufacturing with volatile solvent unless licensed manufacturer
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Business Restrictions

- For commercial cannabis businesses:
 - Sale of both alcohol and cannabis not allowed at or on same premises
 - Businesses must be 600 feet from school, day care center, youth center
 - Local jurisdiction can specify different (greater or smaller)
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Quality Assurance

- All products must be held for testing and quality assurance
 - Representative sample testing by lab
 - Random quality assurance reviews of testing records by state quality assurance compliance monitor
 - Licensee may conduct own additional tests
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Security and Reporting

- Public facilities must implement security measures including anti-loitering, secure areas, secure inventory
 - Retailer required to report diversion, theft, inventory discrepancies
 - Shipping manifest filed with Bureau and kept during transport
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Packaging and Labeling

- Must leave store in opaque package
 - Packages cannot be attractive to children
 - Only generic food names
 - Specific warning language for cannabis and products
 - Regulations likely for additional specified information on label, including weight, chemical makeup, source, allergens
 - Branding and advertising restrictions
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Edibles

- Not attractive to children
- Limit of 10mg of THC per serving
 - Scored or separated by serving size
 - Homogenize for even THC distribution
- Instructions to consumers about how to use and potential effects
- Universal symbol
- Meet standards of uniformity





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Edibles

- Enforcement
 - State Dept. of Public Health can:
 - Order recall
 - Embargo products
 - Issue citations
 - Peace officer may seize
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Advertising and Marketing

- Advertisements must contain info about licensee responsible
 - Audience must be reasonably expected to be 21+
 - No advertising within 1,000 feet of day care, school, playground or youth center
 - No giveaways
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Draft Regulations

- Withdrawn, but new ones anticipated soon
 - Security and food safety requirements
 - Equipment, procedures, chemicals
 - List of prohibited products
 - E.g.: alcohol, hazardous food (hot holding, cold storage, juice), products to apply to existing food product
 - Transportation only in commercial vehicles with locked box
 - But delivery can be in personal vehicle
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Draft Regulations

- THC limits
 - Edibles: 10mg THC/serving, 100mg total
 - Non-edibles: 1,000mg THC total
 - Additional label requirements
 - E.g.: “Schedule I,” nutrition, universal symbol
 - Packaging requirements
 - E.g.: Child resistant, tamper-evident
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
