### PRESS RELEASE

#### CONVICTED SERIAL CHILD MOLESTER FACES LIFE IN PRISON

---

Napa County District Attorney Allison Haley announced today:

On February 8, 2018, Miguel Segura Roman, aged 43, was convicted of 38 counts by a Napa County jury. Defendant was found guilty of 31 counts of lewd and lascivious conduct with a child under 14 years of age, one count of lewd and lascivious conduct with another child under 14 years of age, three counts of sex with a child 10 or younger, and three counts of sexual penetration with a child 10 or younger. The jury also found true special allegations, including that defendant personally inflicted great bodily injury on a child under 14 years of age, defendant committed specified crimes against more than one victim, and defendant engaged in substantial sexual conduct with a child. The Honorable Judge Elia Ortiz presided over the one and a half week jury trial in Napa Superior Court.

The convictions are a result of sexual contact defendant had with two family members who were between 5-13 years old at the time of the molestation. During the trial, both victims testified against him. The case was prosecuted by Napa County Deputy District Attorney Agnes Dziadur who said,

"We are so grateful to the jury for helping the victims, and our community, achieve justice. This case was unlike any other. This defendant engaged in the most profound and gruesome violation of trust imaginable. Our deepest thanks to the Napa County Sheriff's Department, the Napa County District Attorney Investigators, and Sexual Assault Victim Services for their tireless work on this case. The bravery of these victims will never cease to amaze and inspire us. This verdict will ensure that the defendant will never be able to harm them, or any other child, ever again."

Napa County Sheriff's Department Detective Nathalie Hurtado led the investigation.

Defendant is being held on \$1,250,000 bail. He faces a sentence of life in prison for his crimes. Defendant will be back in court for a sentencing hearing on March 12, 2018 at 8:30 in Department H.
