Subject: Wildlife Conservation Commission Grant Funds Available

The Napa County **Wildlife Conservation Commission (WCC)** announces the availability of grant funding and on **July 1, 2020** will begin accepting applications for the **2020 WCC Grant Cycle**. The grants are intended to support the preservation, propagation, and protection of fish and wildlife in Napa County. The funding for these grants is provided by California Department of Fish and Wildlife fines, local fines and settlements, and the general fund.

The total amount of grant funds available for projects varies each year depending upon funding availability and demonstrated project needs. Past grant proposals have included wildlife rehabilitation, native habitat restoration, environmental education programs, and species monitoring studies.

Grant applications are due no later than **Friday, July 31st, 2020**. The WCC is scheduled to meet to review and consider the applications in August. The WCC consists of eight (8) members: Four (4) At-Large/Citizen Representatives, One (1) Sportsman or Angler, One (1) Youth, One (1) Wildlife Conservation Representative, and One (1) Member of the Planning Commission.
