FINAL CERTIFIED RESULTS JUNE 5, 2018 PRIMARY ELECTION

Final certified results of the June 5, 2018 Primary Election are posted to the Napa County Election Division website at <https://www.countyofnapa.org/402/Election-Results>. The detailed Statement of Votes for each contest will be available at the same location on Wednesday June 27, 2018. "Thanks to our dedicated staff, since Election Day we processed and counted an additional 22,405 vote by mail ballots; duplicated 1700 damaged ballots; resolved over 200 conditional voter registrations and performed a manual tally of more than 1,600 paper ballots to confirm these final results," commented Napa County Registrar of Voters John Tuteur. The certification was finished 10 days ahead of the July 5, 2018 deadline.

Turnout for the June 5, 2018 primary election at 49.22% was 10% greater than the 39.55% turnout in June 2014. "We cannot tell whether our pilot status as a Voter's Choice Act county contributed to that increase until we know what the statewide turnout was for the election," Tuteur added. "Napa County's engaged citizenry usually turns out 12 to 13% ahead of the statewide average and in the top 10 of county's with more than 50,000 registered voters." The Secretary of State certifies the statewide turnout after July 5, 2018.
