### Final Certified Results of the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election

The Napa County Election Division has certified the results of the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election. Final certified results including precinct level breakdowns for all contests are posted on the Napa County website <http://www.countyofnapa.org/ElectionResults/>

"I am pleased that once again Napa County voters turned out in greater numbers than the statewide average of approximately 75.1% with 82.3% of our registered voters casting ballots," said John Tuteur, Napa County Registrar of Voters. In statewide voter turnout Napa County currently ranks in the top 6 of the 45 counties having more than 25,000 registered voters.

To arrive at the certified results election division staff and citizen poll workers processed and counted 58,725 vote by mail ballots and 4,530 polling place ballots. Included in those totals are 1,793 ballots that needed duplicating; 559 provisional ballots that could be counted out of 880 provisional ballots that were reviewed and 6,000 ballot images that had to be reviewed individually to confirm voter intent. Prior to certifying three-person teams did a manual tally of 4,075 ballot cards to make sure that human eyes confirmed what the optical scanners counted. "These post Election Day procedures allow candidates and the public to have confidence in the ballot tabulation and optical scanning technologies that we use," added Tuteur.
