### FINAL UNOFFICIAL POST-ELECTION NIGHT RESULTS RELEASED

The final unofficial post-election night results of the November 8, 2016 Presidential Election are posted on the Napa County website at <http://www.countyofnapa.org/ElectionResults/>. “The final unofficial post-election night report contains 63,255 ballots which include the 884 provisional ballots and 1790 duplicated ballots that were processed by our dedicated staff. These results represent an 82.3% turnout of Napa County voters in this important election. We still have to perform a manual tally of approximately 2,000 ballots included in this final count before the certified statement of vote can be published,” Napa County Registrar of Voters John Tuteur advised. Sonoma County has also posted its final results and the Calistoga Joint Unified School District has voters in both counties.

“As Registrar of Voters it is my responsibility to make sure that every vote is counted accurately so that the public can have confidence in the final, certified results which will not change the results because there are no more ballots to count,” Tuteur added. Tuteur hopes to certify the election well before the December 9 deadline set forth in the California Election Code.
