SUISUN MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON IN NAPA HUMAN TRAFFICKING CASE

Napa County District Attorney Allison Haley announced today the sentence of Suisun City resident Harold Edward Domingue, age 36, who was convicted in June, 2018 of felony pandering. Today, the Honorable Judge Mark Boessenecker sentenced Mr. Domingue to state prison for 6 years. The investigation was handled by the Napa Special Investigations Bureau ('NSIB') in collaboration with the Napa County District Attorney's Office.

The conviction stems from an October 2017 investigation into Mr. Domingue's role controlling and profiting from a sex worker in the County of Napa involved in prostitution. The investigation revealed that Mr. Domingue transported the sex worker in and around the County and financially benefitted from her prostitution by using her income to pay his rent and utilities. Mr. Domingue's moniker "Fame" was tattooed on the sex worker's body along with the words "Money Maker."
